10.30 – 12.00 Meeting and talking to the director of the local primary school (Ms Gencsev Plamenné, József Attila Ált. Isk. IX. Mester u. 67.) Coffee and cake. Possibility to see the works of the students in the school.

12.00 – 14.00 A different „face” of Józsefváros, lunch at the Károlyi-Csekonics Palace

14.00 – 17.00 Roundtable discussion about the situation of the challenged students in Hungary, meeting Hungarian experts
